Subject: Delegation of Financial Powers

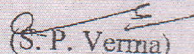
In exercise of the powers conferred on him under Rule 13(3) of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978, as amended, the Textile Commissioner as Head of the Department has delegated his following financial powers to officers of Headquarters office of the Textile Commissioner, Mumbai and its Regional Offices & Powerloom Service Centres to the extent as indicated against each with immediate effect and until further orders.

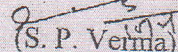

The Textile Commissioner, in exercise of powers conferred by the Ministry of Textiles vide order no.6/5/2015-TUFS dated 28.08.2019, letter no. TS-16015/1/2019-TUFS Section dated 02.02.2021 and in supersession of O.M. No. No.12(1)/ATUFS/Policy/2019/Del. Of Fin Prs/60 dated 15.11.2019, delegated financial power for examining and approving claims under ATUFS to subordinate offices/ officers of the Textile Commissioner as per monetary limit specified hereunder:

Subject: Delegation of Financial Powers to Textile Commissioner for release of subsidy under TUFS

Madam,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.12(1)/ATUFS/Policy/2019/TUFS dated 29.01.2021 on the subject mentioned above and furnish following clarification in the matter:

- As per para 10, the scheme would be implemented by the Textile Commissioner through robust web based software called iTUFS.
- As per para 10.4.3 of ATUFS guidelines, the office of Textiles Commissioner will approve the subsidy claim maximum within 25 working days of filing of JIT report online by RO.
- As per Para 10.5.1, after approval by Textiles Commissioner, automatic challan will be generated in iTUFS.
- As per 10.5.2, Textiles Commissioner will release the eligible subsidy in all individual cases upto Rs. 5.00 crore directly to the entity within 7 days from the date of generation of challan. The challans for the cases with permissible subsidy amount more than Rs. 5.00 crore will be forwarded to Ministry of Textiles after according approval by Textiles Commissioner for obtaining concurrence of IFW and release to the entity”

2. In view of the above provisions in the guidelines, it is clarified that technical examination of the subsidy claims and its certification for admissibility is entrusted with the implementing agency i.e office of Textiles Commissioner. iTUFS platform has been envisaged as an end-to-end solution in implementation of ATUFS in which generation of challans is the final stage of processing of the claims. The challan thus generated by the Office of Textiles Commissioner in the iTUFS platform is envisaged to reflect the certification on admissibility of the claim by office of Textile Commissioner. Further, it is clarified that approval and financial sanction for the claims upto Rs.5.00 crore for which challans have been generated in the iTUFS software will be carried out by Office of Textiles Commissioner and the challans with subsidy value above Rs.5.00 crore will have to be forwarded to Ministry for seeking financial concurrence of IFW and release. The ultimate authority to technically examine and certify the admissibility of the subsidy claim is with office of Textiles Commissioner. Concurrence of IFW will be obtained on the claim amount certified by the office of Textiles Commissioner, to be conveyed through the challan in iTUFS.

3. Since issue of iTUFS Challan is a technical necessity for IFW concurrence, Textiles Commissioner has approval authority for all ATUFS claims. In case of any lacuna found by IFW, the case will have to be sent back to Textile Commissioner for having a fresh examination of the findings raised by IFW or MoT:

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Delegation of power for release of subsidy under TUFS

The Textile Commissioner in exercise of the powers conferred by the Ministry of Textiles vide Order no 6/5/2015-TUFS dated 28th August 2019 (for ATUFS) and Office Memorandum No 16015/01/2019-TUFS dated 28th August 2019 (for previous TUFS) as communicated by the Ministry of Textiles vide its letter No 16012/01/2018-TUFS dated 28th 2019 delegates financial power for examining and approving claims under TUFS as per the monetary limit specified hereunder to subordinate Offices / Officers of the Textile Commissioner:

1. Delegation of financial power for ATUFS:

2. Delegation of financial power for previous versions of TUFS i.e., MTUFS, RTUFS and RRTUFS cases (Except MMS Cases) per case per quarter:

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Note for exercising financial powers thus delegated:

- a) The aforementioned financial power is for per account subsidy claim.
- b) OIC RO will approve the subsidy for the cases, as per financial powers delegated, where eligible machinery has been purchased from enlisted manufacturer / authorized agent.
- c) Notwithstanding anything contained therein before, the aforesaid powers will be exercised at various levels within the ambit of GRs issued from time to time.
- d) No authority is empowered to further delegate the financial power to any of the subordinate authorities.
- e) Subsidy claims will be signed by the In-Charge of Regional Offices at the level of Assistant Director/Deputy Director or above. In his/her absence, the subsidy claim shall be forwarded to the in charge of TUFs cell in Head Office Mumbai for approval thereon.
- f) For cases related to previous versions of TUFs wherever discrepancies in claims submitted by the bank is found by the JIT, RO will seek clarifications from the TUFs Cell of Nodal Bank / Nodal Agencies and if the reply submitted by the bank is found eligible for Subsidy claim then the case may be decided accordingly. In case the discrepancies still persist then the case will be referred to the O/o TxC.
- g) The powers have been delegated for the purpose of approval of subsidy claims which have been recommended by JIT under TUFs.
- h) The delegated powers may be exercised after due diligence by the Officer concerned.
- i) If any claim is required to be rejected for good and sufficient reason, it should be done as per the delegated powers under intimation to Head Office Mumbai.
- j) Subsidy claims rejected at OIC RO level shall be forwarded to Head Office Mumbai for cancellation of UID thereon.
- k) Officer-In-Charge of ROs will ensure overall working of the office and will conduct periodic check/super check.
- l) Henceforth all Challans will be generated at the appropriate level, as per financial powers delegated above, by concerned RO-OIC / Officials through i-TUFs.

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- m) Releases will be made by the Office of the Textile Commissioner, Mumbai based on the Challans as mentioned at (l) above after receiving authorization from the Ministry of Textiles.
- n) All past cases awaiting approval will be covered by this order.
- o) Custodian of the file shall be determined based on the office (HO or RO) which has generated the challan for release of subsidy under the scheme.
