- High cost of imported machines Possible reasons!
- Higher conversion (labour) cost
- ❖ No compromise in certain basic norms even if the customer desires.
- ❖ Payment of Royalty on R & D / design
- * Expensive software for reproducibility
- Machines manufactured for European conditions e.g. Climatic conditions, power connection, drives etc. For Indian supply they have to customise.
- Workers not aware of Indian conditions to be trained specifically.
- Some European buyers insist on installation of machines of specific manufacturers / suppliers as a pre-condition for buying the textile goods from a supplier on the pretext of consistency in quality and reproducability.
- ❖ Indian Manufacturers, have to import expensive automation system.
- Indian manufacturers, depending on the buyers requirement and negotiation, offer a product, compromising on certain specific requirements that may not be necessary for the respective buyer
