(ii) Inclusion of quality control CSP system for spinning sector.

Quality Control CSP system has been included in Annex – B (h) (11) of the GR on TUFS as under :

(iii) Inclusion of Inkjet Engraver/Rotary Screen Engraver under TUFS.

High Speed micro-Inkjet Engraver with UV exposing unit has been included under Annex F 1 & F2 of the GR on TUFS as under:
