Sub: Revised Resolution on ATUFS

The Ministry of Textiles has issued a Revised Resolution on ATUFS vide Resolution No. 06/05/2015-TUFS dated 2nd August 2018.

As per clause 10.1.4 and 10.1.11 of Revised Resolution, the application shall be signed off with the digital signature of the applicant for submission of UID application, and as per clause 10.3.7, the applicant will sign the application with his **digital signature** for making JIT request.

Further as per clause 10.1.6, the Lending Agency will fill in the details of term loan information in i-TUFS and upload the copy of the final sanction order with the **digital signature of the authorised signatory of the lending Agency**. Further, as per clause 10.1.12, Lending Agency will verify the application against the loan documents available with them and upload copy of the final loan sanction order and sign off the verification with the digital signature of the authorized official of the lending agency. The unit is also required to fill the DPR field as per the Format enclosed at the time UID application and the Lending Agency has to digitally sign it.

Accordingly, modifications are being carried out in iTUFS software and it will be implemented with effect from 30.08.2018. As such, all the concerned beneficiary units and Lending agencies are requested to make necessary arrangements so that they could apply with **digital signatures** as above, on or before 30.08.2018
